

SCHEDULE 'A' CONDITIONS
GEORGIAN BAY FOLK SOCIETY SUMMERFOLK MUSIC & CRAFT
FESTIVAL

AUGUST 21-22, 2021

- I. Applicant to provide at their own expense refuse containers. City provides recycling carts and additional garbage cans. The event organizer is responsible for separating the polystyrene cups from the plastic bottles and cans and delivering the cups to the Recycling Depot. Polystyrene materials are not collected in the curb side Blue Box or Blue Cart Programs;
- II. Applicant to provide additional portable washrooms including accessible washrooms and hand cleaning stations;
- III. Applicant to provide designated accessible parking spaces identified with signage;
- IV. \$2,000 damage deposit, the deposit does not relieve the event organizer from assuming liability for all repairs or damages to the facility as a result of their event which exceeds the deposit;
- V. Facility rental fees of \$888.20+HST;
- VI. Prior to event, the Georgian Bay Folk Society will have access to each facility on the date indicated on facility use agreement. These dates range from Saturday, August 14, 2021, to Wednesday, August 18, 2021, for the purpose of setup for teardown;
- VII. Applicant must ensure all electrical installations be inspected by an Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) inspector to ensure compliance with the electrical code and must provide the City with a copy of the inspection report;
- VIII. Applicant must ensure compliance with the Smoke-Free Ontario Act and the County of Grey Smoking By-Law #4872-14; and
- IX. Applicant shall secure all necessary licenses, permits and approvals as required by the City. This includes, but is not limited to road closure permits (if required), Health Unit approvals, locates for underground services, building permit for any tents (larger than 20' x 30') in accordance with the Ontario Building Code and for any other

- erected structures (including bleachers), AGCO license, fire and safety inspections, and all other approvals required under City by-laws and Provincial and Federal legislation;
- X. Applicant will provide at their cost any site services that is required such as electricity and water that are not available within the facility; and
 - XI. Applicant must maintain public access to all City owned locations during set-up and tear down;.
 - XII. Applicant provides \$5-million-dollar general liability insurance naming the City as an additional insured;
 - XIII. Applicant will compensate the city for all and any damages to Kelso Beach arising out of the Licensee's operation for the event in collaboration with the city; and
 - XIV. Applicant to implement the measures outlined in the agreement to reduce the impact of noise on the surrounding neighbourhood.
