Purpose of Tonight's Meeting

- To review the final draft of the 2022 Operating Budget
- Receive staff report with recommendation to direct staff to bring forward a by-law accepting the 2022 Budget as presented



Process to Date







The budget process is ongoing. The formal process begins in the late summer as staff begin to plan and prepare the next year's budget. Operating budgets are carried forward and then changes are made to reflect current year conditions and service levels.

Staff meet as a group to discuss potential recommended and planned capital projects. Going forward this process will be uncoupled from the budget and reviewed more regularly by staff and Council. This cycle, Council meetings were held in three stages to review each component of the budget. The first meeting in November on the Capital budget and the second meeting in December focused on Operating.



Tonight is the final budget meeting to review the completed draft document.

- Staff administered a "call to budget" survey with Council during the 2022 budget process. The following represents the consensus inputs from that survey as well as the commitments within our 2022 budget
 - Overall operating budget increase in line with CPI
 - Most recent annual Ontario CPI released by statistics Canada is 5.0 in November
 - Current operating budget increase excluding Police, Library and Capital is 2.24% over the prior year.
 - ▶ Police increase is 2.49%
 - ► Library increase is 2.17%

Call to Budget



Total Budget (Levy) Increase

- Total levy increase over 2021 is \$1,009,474
 - Increase of \$70,000 from December due to insurance renewal
- ► This represents a 3.19% increase
- Once prior year growth is factored in the impact to existing taxpayers is reduced to 3.0%
- Combining the City levy with the County and Provincial Education Levy estimates a total tax bill increase of 2.72% for a residential tax payer in Owen Sound.
 - (previously was 2.51%; increase is due to insurance renewal)


2022 Operating Budget

- Overall Levy increase is \$1,010,000 or 3.19%
- Combined Municipal rate increase once growth is factored in is 3.00%
- ► Total Tax Bill Increase, including County and School is 2.72%
- Note that any changes in tax policy may impact the municipal rate increase and / or the total tax bill increase.



Operating Expenses by Type




Tax Burden by Strategic Objective
