5.a Deputation from John Slocombe, GM BluePlan Engineering Limited Re: Brooke Storm Water Basin A3 - Master Plan and Study Wrap Up

John Slocombe - GM BluePlan Engineering, shared a PowerPoint presentation regarding the Brooke Storm Water Basin A3 - Master Plan and Study

Committee questioned why the City of Owen Sound has to deal with water running off from Georgian Bluffs. Mr. Slocombe explained that Georgian Bluffs previously constructed a Stormwater Pond at Carney Street, which has significantly mitigated the flooding from large storms. However, there still will be rainfall and snow melt that will affect this area.

Committee asked Mr. Slocombe what they recommended as a first approach. Mr. Slocombe explained that "Reach 2's" main driver, is the poor condition of the box culvert, preventing emergency vehicles and other large vehicles from accessing those residents on 6th Avenue West.

As a taxpayer of Owen Sound, she does not have curbside garbage collection at her home, no snow removal in front of her house, as well as no emergency

vehicles can access her home as the bridge is unable to carry a load of large vehicles due to the deteriorated box culvert.

The Director (A) of Public Works and Engineering explained that the box culvert would be retendered in January to finish the work in early spring.
