5.a Presentation from VS Group Re: Tourism Website Update

The Manager of Community and Business Development introduced Jennifer Cross and Nicole Graham from VS Group who provided an overview of the Tourism Website prototype.

Highlights include:

- An improved search feature;
- Events page and social media collaboration;
- Easier navigation and submission for community events; and
- New section respecting community news; and
- Virtual visitor centre, which allows individuals to navigate the map by category.

The Manager of Community and Business Development noted that the design segment has been completed, and the built phase will now follow. This includes imagery, content, and testing.

In response to a question from Committee, VS Group confirmed that only Owen Sound's postings would be included and not public postings to ensure control of the site is maintained.

#### 8.b Culture

8.b.1 Verbal Report from the Director and Chief Curator of the Tom Thomson Art Gallery Re: Update

The Director and Chief Curator of the Tom Thomson Art Gallery provided a verbal report respecting a gallery update.

The current and upcoming exhibitions were highlighted, including:

- o a new exhibition by the regional artist Nicholas Bent;
- a new exhibition of Tom Thomson's work and other works from the collection; and,
- o the ongoing exhibition Showing 55.

Public projects and events were also highlighted:

 The Gallery has applied for a grant that would support the initial stages of the OPEN Team Pollinator Corridor Project; a stakeholder meeting was held on November 14;

- Teimojin Tan, a local doctor, will be providing a talk respecting his experiences;
- Collaborations with Coffin Ridge and Georgian Bay Symphony are in development; and
- Gallery Night at the Movies has successfully kicked off after a hiatus due to the pandemic.

It was noted that 110 works from the collection are currently on view in various exhibitions.

The facility renovation was highlighted and will be occurring beginning in January 2023. The renovation focuses on accessibility, including replacing the elevator and front entrance steps. The Gallery will remain open during the renovations; however, will not be accessible.

The Committee advised that the 2023 Tom Thomson calendars are now available for purchase. A total of \$55,000 has been raised in the last three years.
