


Lutheran Social Services Owen Sound

St. Clare Place

- LSS has applied for project funding from CMHC under the Rapid Housing Initiative Program. The project will not proceed unless funding is obtained.
- The Rapid Housing Initiative will start July 1st, 2023 if the funding is approved. The funding announcement should be made in early June.
- The rent will be set at severe core housing income level. This is at the lowest end income level.

- Grey County Housing is contributing \$3M toward the project. Some of this money is designated for rent subsidy and some for capital funding.
- Tenants will be 65 and over selected from Grey County's waiting list for subsidized housing.
- If LSS does not receive funding under Rapid Housing, then we will explore other funding programs.
