Impact of the YMCA & City of Owen Sound Partnership Since 2009

- Community Enrichment: We have offered essential health, recreation, educational programs, and cultural activities, benefiting thousands of residents annually.
- **Collaborative Effort:** The partnership has enabled the delivery of services that would not have been possible independently, thanks to the unique financial contributions from both parties.
- Significant Financial Commitment: The YMCA supported the Capital Campaign for the Julie McArthur Regional Recreation Centre with a \$7.39 million contribution from donations and proceeds from the sale of the original YMCA facility.
- Long-Term Impact: Approval of a 20-year Operational Agreement and Lease in 2024 supports a long-term partnership, allowing the YMCA to continue to empower individuals, strengthen the community's well-being, and offering significant opportunities for growth.

The YMCA Facility at the JMRRC

- In our operational model as a partner of the City of Owen Sound, we take
 pride in managing our own revenue and expenses and covering the costs of
 operations and capital for our 55,000 square foot health, fitness and aquatics
 facility, as well as cost-sharing expenses related to the common areas of the
 Julie McArthur Regional Recreation Centre building and site.
- Amenities within this fully accessible facility include:
 - √ 8 lane, 25-meter swimming pool with accessible ramp
 - ✓ Warm water leisure/therapy pool with water features and an accessible ramp
 - ✓ Spacious Fitness Centre with high-end fitness equipment
 - ✓ Cycle Studio with Keiser spinning bikes
 - ✓ Free-weight room
 - ✓ 2-Lane walking/running track

- ✓ Multi-sport gymnasium
- ✓ Womens and Mens adult-only change rooms with steam rooms
- ✓ Girls and boys youth change rooms
- ✓ Co-ed Family change room
- ✓ Welcome Desk, always staffed
- ✓ Two program rooms equipped with kitchenettes
- ✓ Pool viewing area, lobby seating

YMCA Member Information

- We continue to see strong membership growth and anticipate a return to pre-COVID membership levels (5,600) this fiscal year.

 Historical averages show Owen Sound residents account for approximately 75% of members.



Investment in the JMRRC

- Since the Centre opened in June of 2012, the YMCA has continued to make strategic investments to keep the YMCA facility in "as new" condition, in order to meet the high expectations of members and to contribute to the longevity and sustainability of the building and property owned by the City of Owen Sound.
- Between opening and March 31, 2023, the YMCA invested almost **\$1.5 million** in capital maintenance and repairs for the YMCA portion of the facility, including expansion of the parking lot, which was a shared expense with the City of Owen Sound.
- The facility has also been assessed by and engineering firm, Ameresco, in order to evaluate and project upcoming Capital investments required of the YMCA.

Energy Efficient Upgrades

August 26, 2023 - During the 2023 annual shutdown the YMCA upgraded the facility's lighting system to LED, a change designed to reduce operating costs and support our commitment to sustainability. These improvements not only lower energy consumption but also contribute to a more environmentally friendly operation, reflecting our ongoing dedication to finding innovative solutions for energy efficiency in our YMCA.



Pool Repairs

August 26, 2023 - During the annual facility shutdown our pools underwent essential refurbishment to address extensive tile repairs and ensure their continued safety and longevity. This critical maintenance was part of our commitment to maintaining our cherished facilities in the best possible condition for the health and safety of our YMCA community. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this necessary shutdown.



New Steam Room Unit Installed

February 15, 2024 - Despite a thorough engineering study, the men's steam room heating unit involving the thermostat and heating elements, failed prematurely due to tampering. After several months of anticipation, the new unit has arrived and been installed. The facilities team adeptly navigated a few challenges during the installation, ensuring the steam room could resume operation and provide a comfortable experience for our members.



Igniting a New Beginning

March 14, 2024 - The YMCA of Owen Sound Grey Bruce is excited to announce the relocation of some of its services to the historic Sun Times Building. With the support of the owner, JP Commercial Contracting Inc, Andy Smit, this move allows us to expand and enhance the programs and services offered to the community. By relocating to this iconic location, the YMCA aims to bring new energy and accessibility to its offerings, fostering a vibrant community hub where individuals and families can come together to participate in health, wellness, and support programs. The new space will allow for a broader range of activities and resources, continuing the YMCA's tradition of igniting community spirit and bringing light to the community.

YMCA Investment in The River District

- Over 75 staff now work in the YMCA ACES+ Building located in the historic Sun Times Building (Association Services, Community, Employment & Settlement Services+).
- Services delivered at this fully accessible, completely renovated site include: employment, settlement and language, justice/diversion, and services for youth transitioning out of the child welfare system.



What's Shining on the Horizon (2025/26)

- \$250k = completion of the Health, Fitness & Aquatics Green Space with an accessible playscape and shelter; additional donors required to fulfill this vision.
- \$506k = Community Sport and Recreation Infrastructure Fund Grant Application, which was accompanied by a letter of support from the City of Owen Sound; this would provide for provincial funding for 50% of the costs associated with:
 - ✓ Asset Planner Software (Preventative Maintenance, Capital Plan)
 - ✓ Heating Boilers (2), Steam Generators (2)
 - ✓ Supply Blower Motor, Condenser Fan Motors/Blades (6)
 - ✓ Coaxial Heat Exchangers (3)
 - √ Fitness Centre Flooring
