Details/Purpose of the illumination event: *

Every year on February 11, the United Ways of Canada network and locally, the United Way of Bruce Grey come together to recognize 211 Day. This annual event raises awareness about the vital role that 211 plays in our community.

211 is Canada's primary source of information for government and community-based, non-clinical health and social services. It is a free, confidential service available in over 150 languages via phone, chat, text, and web. The service acts as a front door to essential support, helping individuals navigate the often-complex network of government and community programs and services to find the help they need.

211 was brought to Bruce and Grey Counties by the United Way of Bruce Grey in 2009. The United Way. The United Way invested in 211 as early as 2005 to bring this valuable service to Ontario's first rural 211 community. The online database launched in 2008 with the phone service coming online on February 11th 2009, creating the first 211-Day! Today both Bruce and Grey County along with other funders ensure that 211 is a front door for local community programs.

In 2024 9,197 needs were identified through calls to 211 from Bruce and Grey Counties.

40% of those calls related to housing

Unfortunately in those calls, 1118 were identified as an unmet need. That the resources needed either was full (507 calls), the caller was ineligible (272) or there was no resource (260).

80% of the unmet needs were related to housing.

Description of your organization including a brief history and any other relevant information: *

The United Way is an autonomous organization, which builds upon the strength of volunteers and voluntary action by engaging the whole community for the benefit of the whole community. Governed by a local Board of Directors along with other volunteers and staff, we help to build caring communities and respond to a broad range of human needs on a local scale.

The United Way was founded in 1998 and has been headquartered in Owen Sound since 2001, and has owned it's current location since July of 2006.
