Water Meter Replacement



The majority of the water meters currently installed in Owen Sound's residential properties are at the end of their lifespan. The City is undertaking a mass replacement project to replace these old meters with new ones and upgrade the technology in the meter transmission system to reduce the time required to read them. This upgraded technology will allow residents to be more aware of their water consumption and possible leaks and will facilitate the eventual transition to monthly billing.
